2. Literature Review (Font: Arial - 10, Bold)

This section is dedicated to the significant literature resources that contributed to the research. The author should survey scholarly articles, books and other sources relevant to the area of research, providing a description, summary, and critical evaluation of each work. (Font: Arial -9)

3. Methodology (Font: Arial - 10, Bold)

This section should contain detailed information about the procedures and steps followed. It can be divided into subsections if several methods are described. (Font: Arial – 9)

The author should clearly explain the important conclusions of the research highlighting its significance and relevance. (Font: Arial – 9)

References to the work should follow the 7th APA style and carefully checked for accuracy and consistency. Please ensure that every reference cited in the text is also present in the reference list and vice versa.
